Pilot Plan: Early Childhood Development Program for Fiji

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Customize the program to Fiji's unique cultural and logistical context.

Develop a cutting-edge, culturally relevant ECD

curriculum for 3-6-year-olds based on global

Train and certify teachers using Khanmigo,

ensuring high-quality delivery.

Lay the foundation for scalability and global accreditation.









Key Deliverables

Teacher Training & Certification:

• Digital training modules delivered via Khanmigo, emphasizing pedagogy, classroom management, and local adaptations.

• Teacher certification aligned with UNESCO and national standards.

Monitoring & Reporting:

• Real-time tracking of student outcomes, teacher performance, and overall program effectiveness through Khanmigo analytics.

Curriculum Design:

• A comprehensive ECD curriculum combining global best practices (Montessori, Reggio Emilia, Finnish models) and Fijian cultural elements (e.g., storytelling, local crafts).

• Age-appropriate activities focused on literacy, numeracy, social-emotional learning, and environmental awareness

Pilot Implementation:

• Launch in a showcase community hub in Fiji, equipped with Starlink-powered connectivity and solar power for reliability.

Accreditation:

• Prepare program documentation for global accreditation with UNESCO and UNICEF Pacific.



Budget Estimate (Pilot Phase)

Curriculum Development	\$10,000
Khanmigo Licensing & Support	\$15,000/year
Teacher Training & Certification	\$5,000
Starlink Setup & Connectivity	\$2,000 (initial setup)
Solar Power Installation	\$3,000
Pilot Hub Setup (Materials, Furniture, Supplies)	\$10,000
Monitoring & Evaluation	\$3,000
Total Estimated Budget	\$48,000

Partner with local schools, NGOs, and village leaders to ensure community buy-in and participation.




Technology Support

Roadmap for Teacher Certification



Develop Khanmigo-powered training modules based on global ECD standards and localized needs. Offer digital micro-certifications for key skills (e.g., pedagogy, classroom management).
